Clive Human, a psychologist and Director of the organisation S.T.O.P (Standing Together to Oppose Pornography) will address the parents on Tuesday 22 May 2018 at 6:30 pm in the Chelsea Campus Hall. S.T.O.P. has gained support from schools, churches of various denominations, and NGO organisations in their presentations to raise awareness of the dangers and harmful effects of adult and child pornography. Clive has been involved with S.T.O.P for twenty two years, and as the Director for ten years. He has spoken on radio and television, and at international conferences.
