Last year Chelsea Prep implemented Thinking Maps into their teaching and Chelsea is now part of TSSA (Thinking Schools SA). Pupils are encouraged to solve problems and think creatively and critically. It uses 8 maps to develop essential thinking skills and can be used in various combinations and complexity to assist in developing our concepts and later on in Senior Primary, learning for tests and exams.
