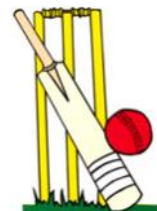

## U9B CRICKET

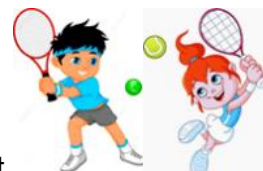
So proud of our cricket boys. We won by 53 runs and they played their best!
